In Design Technology, Year 4 have been busy designing and making cushions. The children evaluated different designs, sewing techniques and decorations before beginning work on their prototypes.


















In PE, Year 4 have been evaluating their performances of their own versions of the Haka.

During their Understanding the World sessions in February, the Reception children became scientists! The small world penguins had been frozen in icebergs and the children needed to work out the best way to release them.

The children chose 4 different variables, made predictions and carried out a fair test. The children observed the icebergs for an hour during the afternoon and then discussed their findings.

Although they predicted the sun or hot water would melt the ice the quickest; the iceberg that melted the quickest was actually the one they added salt to! This prompted lots of discussion and prompted the children to want to know why!











Developing our skills in Lacrosse - Year 6

Year 6 have been continuing to develop their knowledge and skills in PE as they learnt how to play Lacrosse.

The children put their skills to the test in small game scenarios.






I Will Project with LFC Foundation - Year 5








Exploring media in art - Year 1!

Celebrating Number Day!


Number Day!

Later in the day the children went head-to-head with their class teachers in a special 'Beat the Teacher' number quiz.








Celebrating Success!

Reminder - Update on Key Stage 2 SATs Dates

Gov.uk have confirmed that an additional bank holiday in honour of the Coronation of His Majesty King Charles III will take place on Monday 8 May 2023.

As this date had previously been announced as the first day of the 2023 key stage 2 (KS2) test week in England, gov.uk have confirmed that a change to the KS2 test schedule next year will be necessary.

The new KS2 SATs schedule will be:

Tuesday 9 May: EGPS papers 1 (questions) & 2 (spelling)

Wednesday 10 May: English Reading paper

Thursday 11 May: Mathematics papers 1 (arithmetic) and 2 (reasoning)

Friday 12 May: Mathematics paper 3 (reasoning)


Attendance -Holidays in Term Time

Please ensure your child arrives at school in time to be through the door **before 9:00am**, to ensure they are in class on time.

Doors must close at 9:00am prompt to enable support staff to arrive to lessons on time.

Pupils entering through the main entrance from 9:00am will be marked late. Any late pupils must be escorted to the main entrance by their adult, in order to ensure they arrive safely and have their attendance registered.



PE Kit

Please remember to send your child into school in their PE Kit on PE days.

A reminder of the school PE kit is detailed below.

PE Kit

On the day that your child has PE, please send them into school already wearing their PE kit. They will remain in their PE kit for the duration of the day. The PE Kit for Barlows is as follows:

- Navy blue Barlows school jumper or cardigan
- Plain white T-shirt (plain or with Barlows logo. Logo optional)
- Plain navy blue jogging bottoms and/or navy blue shorts (plain or with Barlows logo. Logo optional)
- Trainers suitable for sports activities.
- Not permitted Football kits, gym leggings, gym tops, hoodies, tracksuit tops or other branded clothing are not permitted.

All clothes should be plain and free from large brand logos to avoid brand competition and peer pressure amongst children.
