Information regarding Spelling Homework Years 1-6

Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of our implementation of our new ambitious English CUSP Curriculum, we are introducing weekly spelling tests for the children in Years 1-6. Feedback at parents' evenings and parent meetings has welcomed this as a positive step for learning.

Spelling Focus

The spelling tests will complement the explicit spelling lessons delivered as part of the new English Curriculum. The weekly spellings will be linked to the specific spelling rule that the children will have been looking at during the week. These have been mapped out and will be available on the school website from Monday 27/11/23 at the latest. However, the current spellings for your child will be available in their spelling book from today.

Organisation & Dates

Fridays	Each Friday, your child will bring home their new Spelling Record Book with the new spelling list stuck the front of the book.
Friday – Wednesday	Practise at home with the Spelling Record book. The children will practise their spellings throughout the week and return their Spelling record the following Wednesday. Spelling practise is available via the Spelling Frame website throughout, which is detailed below. Logins are inside the Spelling Record book. PLEASE DO NOT WRITE IN THE SPELLING RECORD
Wednesday	Spelling Records are returned to school. Spelling Practice continues using Spelling Frame online.
Thursday	Weekly Spelling Test takes place in the back of the Spelling Record.
Friday	Spelling Books are sent home. You will be able to see how the children have achieved on their weekly spelling test when they bring their spelling records home each Friday. This will help to keep you updated in terms of your child's progress and is also an opportunity for you to revisit any word/s with your child/ren if necessary.

The children can use this at home to practise their spellings. There are many interactive games on the program which are linked to the spelling rules/word lists for each year group.


The pupils have already used this in class and have been practising how to navigate the site with their teachers. Feedback from pupils has been very positive in using the interactive games.


